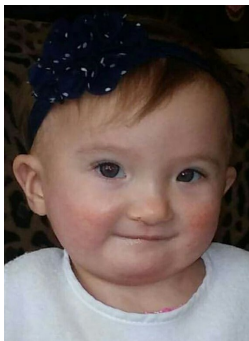
Evan Adams Memorial Benefit Ride

Meet **Savannah Harrison** – Louisa, VA.

A beautiful 1 year old girl, Savannah was born on February 26, 2016.

Now a little over 13lbs and 25 inches long, Savannah was diagnosed with a chromosome 16 deletion. It is reported that only 26 people in the entire world have this missing chromosome and Savannah is UVA's only patient with this condition.

Due to this missing chromosome Savannah was born with several birth defects. She has a cleft pallet and has undergone surgery to repair it. Surgeons advise that she still has a hole in the roof of her mouth and will have to undergo a second surgery during the summer of 2017.

Savannah lacks strength in her mouth therefore she is unable to eat food and has to drink her food from a special bottle. Savannah is growth restricted and was born at 36 weeks at 3lbs, 15 ounces.

Savannah was also born with overlapping toes and low placed ears and doctors say it is possible she may lose her hearing. She is currently learning sign language and has physical therapy every week and speech therapy every month.
